

How do I set up RDI values for those nutrients which do not have them?

SERVE provides you with RDI values for many of the nutrients provided with SERVE. Unfortunately we do not have RDI values for all nutrients. You can add your own RDI values for any of the remaining nutrients, or for any nutrients you have added to the SERVE database (adding nutrients is described in training guide 24).

Setting up RDI values is an advanced/restricted function, and to do this you will need to log on as “SUPERVISOR” and enter in the supervisor password.

From the main menu bar,



select **General**, then select **Nutrients**. The maintain nutrients window is displayed as shown below:

Drag the scroll bar down to select the nutrient you want to set up RDI values for. Click on the RDI value column for the nutrient and select “True”(or select False to remove RDI values for a nutrient).



Click  and the program will set up zero RDI values for that nutrient for each of the RDI groups.


From the main menu bar, select **General**, then select **RDIs** to enter the RDI values for this nutrient.

For each of the persons you have on your database you will then need to reset the RDI values to include these new nutrient values for the person. To do this select **Person** then select **Person details** from the main menu bar.



Click  and then click 



to reload the RDI values and hence include the new nutrient RDI value. Using the  button step through the person details and reset the RDIs for each person.



You can now view these new RDI values in your food intakes and recipes.
