

How do I switch between the default and alternative database(s)?

General information

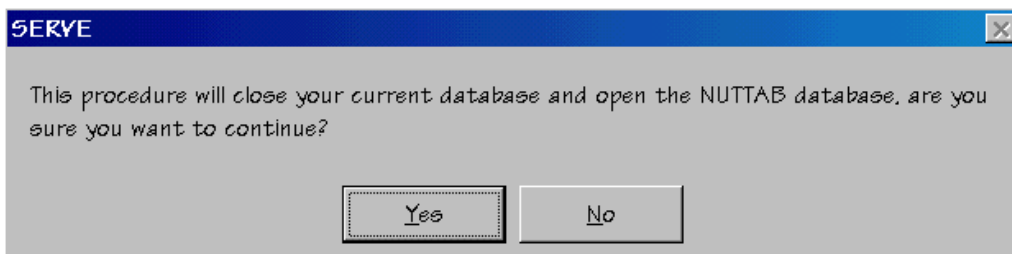
SERVE provides you with a default database (AUSNUT in Australia and FOODFILES in New Zealand). Depending on the version you have chosen there may be one or more alternative databases (such as NUTTAB or the ANZFA Recipes Database). The title at the top of the main menu bar tells you the name of the database to which you have access. The example menu bar below shows you have access to AUSNUT (one of the databases you access by default)



Procedure to switch to alternative database

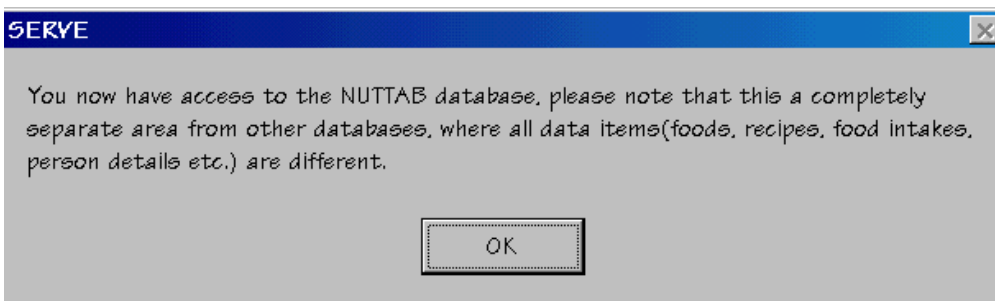
From the main menu bar, select **File**, then select **switch to NUTTAB** (or whichever 'switch to' database you have access to). Note that if no "switch to" options are displayed you only have access to the one database.

The window is displayed as shown below:



Click to proceed (or to cancel).

The following message will be displayed:



Click you now have access to the the alternative database (NUTTAB in this example).

To switch back to default database

From the main menu bar select **File**, then select **switch to AUSNUT (or FOODFILES) database**.

Click to proceed, then click you now have access to the default AUSNUT (or FOODFILES) data again



To default to NUTTAB (Australian databases users only)

SERVE automatically starts with access to AUSNUT by default. To have SERVE start with the NUTTAB database by default you need to create an icon on your desktop as follows:

On a blank area of your PC desktop click the right mouse button. Select New, then select Shortcut.

In the Command line field type the following exactly as shown:

```
"c:\program files\serve\servea.exe" NUTTAB
```

Then click  and then click . An icon is created on your desktop. When you double click this SERVE will start using NUTTAB as the default database.



To default to ANZFA (ANZFA Recipes database)

SERVE automatically starts with access to AUSNUT by default. To have SERVE start with the ANZFA recipes database by default you need to create an icon on your desktop as follows:

On a blank area of your PC desktop click the right mouse button. Select New, then select Shortcut.

In the Command line field type the following exactly as shown:

```
"c:\program files\serve\servea.exe" ANZFA
```

Then click  and then click . An icon is created on your desktop. When you double click this SERVE will start using ANZFA recipes database as the default database.

To default to the new NUTTAB06 or AUSNUT07 (Australian databases users only)

To have SERVE start with the new NUTTAB06 or AUSNUT07 database by default perform the procedure as above, but using the following command line for NUTTAB06:

```
"c:\program files\serve\servea.exe" NUT-TAB06
```

or the following command line for AUSNUT07:

```
"c:\program files\serve\servea.exe" AUSNUT07
```
